Generation 3 Upgrade Promotion

If you're one of the hundred or so customers that are still running Dynamite 2000 or even the original DOS version, now's the time to upgrade.

Not only will we credit your original purchase but until June 30, 2003, we'll further reduce the upgrade price by another \$500.00!

Here's an example:

Suppose you're running Dynamite 2000 with SBT Pro 5.0 and have a 5-user license. You currently have a software subscription (cost = \$500) which has six months left. You originally paid \$2,995 three years ago.

You wish to upgrade to Dynamite Generation 3 but only need a 3-user license. The price of G3 integrated with ACCPAC Pro is \$3,995 plus \$400 for each additional user license after the first one. That's a total of \$4,795.

To calculate your cost, first subtract the original cost from the new price and also subtract the balance of your software subscription. The result is \$1,550. If you act before June 30th, your cost will be only \$1,050.

Dynamite is able to import Job Site addresses from your customer tables via the Export-Import function on the Transaction Menu. Both the Ship To data base and the Customer data base can be imported. The resulting job site number is a combination of the customer number and that customer's ship to address number. Job site numbers are not duplicated in the system.

E-Mail Spam

Canning spam hog-ties net set

Direct marketers are up in arms over the Australian government's plans to introduce strict laws on spam.

Bulk commercial e-mails - spam - which push everything from cheap computer equipment to gambling to hardcore pornography, are loathed by most Internet users.

The problem is growing exponentially with research company Gartner Group predicting that in two years 50 per cent of e-mails received will be unwanted spam.

The National Office for Information Economy proposes banning the sending of unsolicited commercial e-mails without prior consent of the recipient such as through an opt-in agreement or existing business relationship.

The Communications and Information Technology Office acknowledged that although most spam originated from overseas, the legislation would still be effective and the government intended to work with overseas bodies on international enforcement. Punitive measures could include incarceration. Editor's Note: Punitive measures mean jail time!

Back in the U.S., Senator Conrad Burns of Montana has introduced legislation to require legitimate return addresses and honor removal requests. Also, it is now a felony to send 10,000 deceptive e-mails to or from the State of Virginia.

While no one wants more laws, they are needed because spamming is uncontrolled and Internet operators cannot or will not take action. Our hope is that proposed regulations don't get watered down.

South By Southwest has designed and is currently testing a new Direct Mail Program targeting portions of the 3,000,000 service organizations in the U.S. Initial results are very promising.

Like everything else we do, this program is unique. First, it is much cheaper than other programs. Second, you don't have to do anything except answer the phone and make follow up calls. Third, your cost is refundable in a reverse co-op program.

Accounting System News

Dynamite is tightly integrated with 15 versions of five different accounting systems published by 3 different companies.



Visual AccountMate is the highest rated open source code accounting software offered to the mid-market, according to Softline AccountMate's president, Murray Aston. "But don't take our word for this," he says. "Ask the experts."

For mid-market companies, perhaps the most vital attribute of business and accounting software is the flexibility that only comes from open-source code. "Big companies take customization for granted," according to Geni Whitehouse, CPA, chief operating officer for Accounting Software Advisor (ASA), an industry consulting group founded by accounting software analyst Carlton Collins. "However, few mid-market companies realize they need this feature to remain competitive. But if you're stuck with an application you can't modify, you can't maintain the system long-term."

In evaluating business accounting systems, ASA determined that Visual AccountMate was the premiere open-source code system in the mid-market. It ranked second in overall performance, right behind Microsoft's Great Plains Dynamics, which lacks open-source flexibility.

CPA Software News awarded 5 STARS to there ACCPAC product last month:

Simply Accounting Basic and Simply Accounting Pro 2003 from ACCPAC International contain the necessary tools to run the finances of a businesses from small to supporting them as they grow. Both products come in American and Canadian versions that adhere to GAAP standards and are very inexpensive, off-the-shelf contenders in the low-end accounting category providing functions for GL, AP/AR, Payroll, purchasing, basic inventory and job costing as well as a full audit trail. The Pro version also provides a Time and Billing module and

EFT (electronic funds transfer) capabilities as well as a range of advanced features such as multi-currency, multiple level bill of materials management, 100 years of history, departmental accounting and multi-user support. ACCPAC has added a few new features to both products this year that increase the usability of the programs as well as their capabilities.

- Object Oriented Programming means stable code that eases the task of customization.
- Language settings by user allow you to not only operate different languages in the same company but to even personalize the menus and screens for each user.
